

To participate in a WSMLA sponsored shoot, (Winter Challenge, State Shoot and State Bench) participants must also be members of the WSMLA. The WSMLA board is also looking for ways to help sponsor “**new**” shooters to the state contest. The WSMLA voted to allow minors under the legal age of majority in Wyoming (age 19) who are sponsored by a paid member of the WSMLA to participate under that member sponsorship at state contests. The board is also discussing some sort of change to the requirement that paid membership required in WSMLA to participate in state sponsored contests.
